

Synchro NB Registration Guidelines 2017-2018

1. All clubs are asked to register their clubs, competitive athletes and competitive coaches on the Synchro Canada Online registration system by **October 31st**.
2. All clubs will register their recreational athletes, recreational coaches and any other members on the Synchro Canada online registration system no later than **November 15th**.
3. All clubs are asked to complete the Synchro NB registration form and submit it to Synchro NB with payment no later than November 30th.
4. Individuals must register in all categories that apply to them. However, they need to pay only one. The highest registration fee is the one that is paid.
5. Synchro NB will register all Provincial and National Officials, and cover the registration fees for all officials.
6. Any questions regarding registrations should be made to the Synchro NB Registration Chair.
7. The Synchro NB Registration Chair will complete the Synchro Canada registration form and submit with payment to Synchro Canada no later than **November 30th**. Note that the deadline for registration and payment of dues with Synchro Canada is **December 15th** (this is a hard deadline: registrations received after this date will incur a penalty).
8. For athletes, coaches, board members or volunteers who join after the fall deadline:
 - a. The clubs will register them with Synchro NB by completing the registration form by **the last day of the month in which they became active**. (eg; If a *new* athlete joins a rec program in January, the club will register this athlete by January 31st).
 - b. The fees are the same as they would be for the full term.
 - c. The clubs will register them online on the Synchro Canada site.
 - d. The clubs will provide payment to Synchro NB within a reasonable amount of time.
 - e. The Synchro NB Registration Chair will inform the treasurer, who will issue payment to Synchro Canada.
9. For officials or Synchro NB Board Members becoming active after the fall registration deadline, the Synchro NB registration chair will register them online with Synchro Canada as soon as possible. The treasurer will issue payment to Synchro Canada.

SYNCHRO NB - REGISTRANT/MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Clarification

Provincial/Territorial Member Synchro New Brunswick

Competitive Clubs Any Club with registered Competitive Swimmers

Recreation Clubs A Club with only registered Recreational Swimmers

Competitive Swimmers N/S All National Stream athletes. This does not include any 11-12 P/S athletes who compete at Espoir.

Competitive Swimmers P/S Includes Novice and Provincial Stream athletes. This category includes any 11-12 athletes who compete at Espoir.

Masters Swimmers Masters competitor at all levels.

Short Term Recreational Swimmer Recreational athletes who participate in a summer camp, seasonal program, or other types of non-competitive programming for a period of six weeks or less in one membership year.

Recreational Swimmers Athletes enrolled in a recreational synchronized swimming program that is more than six weeks in duration.

Recreational Coaches A coach who will be coaching a recreational program on-deck within their local club.

Provincial Coaches A coach who will be coaching only provincial stream athletes on-deck within their local club and/or at provincial, national and/or international sanctioned meets.

National Coaches A coach who will be coaching any National Stream athletes on-deck within their local club and/or at provincial, national and/or international sanctioned meets.

Provincial Officials Includes all Level I and II officials, and the provincial scoring chair. Officials-in-Training (practice judges) are considered to be volunteers until they are certified.

National Officials All Officials with Level III status and higher.

Associate Registrant Those individuals who are active within their member provincial organizations (club executives, Board members, alumni etc.), and those who attend Annual Meetings and/or exercise a role at Synchro Canada meetings

Volunteer Members Any individual who donates their time during a Synchro NB sanctioned event. Volunteers are registered when they sign the waiver at the event.

Socan License Paid by Synchro NB, this allows our members to play music without infringing on copyright laws.

Leagues (CUSSL) A league that offers synchronized swimming competitions that does not participate within the national qualification event system.

League Affiliates University Athlete or coach who participates in the university league in Canada.

Program Licensee Any other organization (includes universities, schools, community centres, municipal or private aquatic facilities) offering a Synchro Canada recreational program.

*Athletes with a disability (AWAD) are athletes who meet the classification guidelines as set out by the Paralympic Organization. Clubs registering athletes with a disability should inform Synchro NB, as special funding can be provided to assist with coaching.
